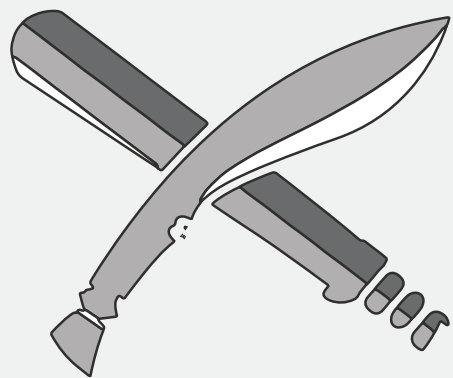

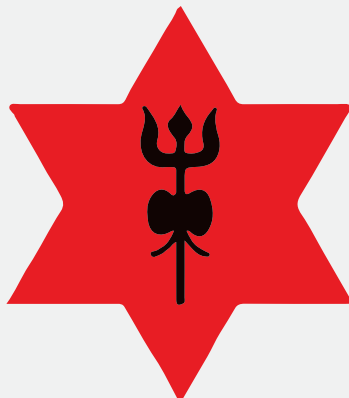

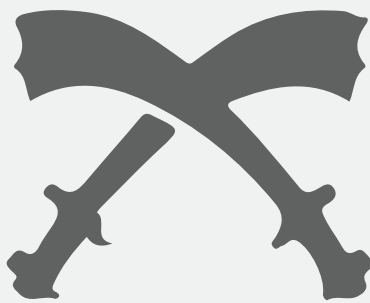

# REGARDING THE PROGRESS WITH THE TUNNEL IN VARIOUS HYDROPOWER IN RASUWA AND NUWAKOT DISTRICT:

Upper Trisuli 216 MW- Nepali Army with foreign specialists; tunnel blocked by thick mud and debris.

Chilime- Nepali and Indian teams working jointly; mud and rocks obstruct progress.

Langtang- 25 rescuers deployed; team reached approximately 150 metres.

Trisuli 3 B- 61 soldiers, three civilians and the project's managing director deployed; excavator used to create access.

Rasuwadagadi- Team reached approximately 150 metres; large rocks block further access. Search remains ongoing.
